To Whom It May Concern:

Hunter Douglas and its subsidiary trade brands are held to a high standard via a robust internal lead testing program. The program requires each brand to submit samples of their componentry each year for lead testing in Hunter Douglas's internal lab, and if necessary, an independent third-party lab. The samples are not only required to conform to the current ANSI U.S. safety standard of a lead concentration of 200 parts per million, (0.02% lead by weight), but requires them to be compliant with the stricter Canadian requirement of 90 ppm (0.009% lead by weight).

Comfortex has participated in the lead testing program since its inception in 2015 and between 2017 and 2018 submitted 790 samples to the lab for analysis. The samples have conformed to the strict parameters set by Hunter Douglas. Comfortex will continue to submit samples to the lab for examination, as required by policy, each year.
